BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on January 18, 1989, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Victor T. Lyon.

NOW, on this 3rd day of February, 1989, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) At the time of the hearing, the attorney for ARCO Oil and Gas Company stated that there was no further need for the special pool rules promulgated by Order No. R-8470 and said rules should be rescinded.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) The special pool rules promulgated by Order No. R-8470 for the West Anderson Ranch-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, are hereby rescinded.

(2) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


