 - "(4) The applicant is entitled to a 142 barrel a day allowable effective January 24, 1987, and any overproduction which has accumulated since January 24, 1987, is to be made up by producing the well at a rate of 100 barrels per day, from date of this order, until said overproduction has been eliminated."
- (2) The corrections set forth in this order be entered nunc pro $\underline{\text{tunc}}$ as of July 23, 1987.
