ORDER OF DISMISSAL

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10:00 o'clock a.m. on August 22, 1956, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before Daniel S. Nutter, Examiner duly appointed by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this 27<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced and the recommendations of the Examiner, Daniel S. Nutter, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That applicant by its agent entered an appearance and moved to dismiss the cause.

(3) That said cause should therefore be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of Ohio Oil Company for an order granting an unorthodox location and the assignment of a normal unit allowable for its proposed well to be located 1650 feet from




