ORDER OF THE COMMISSION BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. on June 27, 1956, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Warren W. Mankin, Examiner duly appointed by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Rule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this $\sqrt{7^{t^n}}$ day of September, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced, the recommendations of the Examiner, Warren W. Mankin, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant is the operator of the Cagle "C" No. 1 gas well located 990 feet from the North and West lines of Section 3, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, which was recompleted as a gas well in the Jalmat Gas Pool on May 10, 1956, which date is subsequent to the effective date of the Special Rules and Regulations for the Jalmat Gas Pool as set forth in Order R-520.
- (3) That applicant proposes to dedicate the NW/4 and the E/2 of said Section 3 to its aforementioned Cagle "C" No. 1 Well.
- (4) That the applicant by the evidence adduced has failed to make an adequate showing that its Cagle "C" No. 1 Well is capable of efficiently draining the proposed non-standard gas

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proration unit; therefore, the subject application should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That the application of Amerada Petroleum Corporation for a non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the NW/4 and the E/2 of Section 3, Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, be and the same is hereby denied.
