FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Justis Gas Pool, the Lovington-Paddock Pool, and the Young Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Justis Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(b) That the Lovington-Paddock Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM Section 4: NW/4

(c) That the Young Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:
