NUNC PRO TUNC ORDER

BY THE DIVISION:

It appearing to the Division that Order No. R-9544 dated July 1, 1991, does not correctly state the intended order of the Division,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

(1) Finding Paragraph No. 5 on page 2 of said Division Order No. R-9544 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(5) There is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Blinebry formation, said pool to bear the designation of South House-Blinebry Pool. Said South House-Blinebry Pool was discovered by the Seay Exploration Inc. House Well No. 1 located in Unit D of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM. It was completed in the Blinebry formation on February 28, 1991. The top of the perforations is at 6,008 feet."

(2) Decretory Paragraph (d) on page 4 of said Order No. R-9544 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"(d) A new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Blinebry production is hereby created and designated as the South House-Blinebry Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 20 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST, NMPM  
Section 13: NW/4"


