ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on November 19, 1992, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Michael E. Stogner.

NOW, on this 23rd day of November, 1992, the Division Director, having considered the record and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS THAT:

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, SG Interests I, Ltd., seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Basin-Fruitland Coal Gas Pool underlying Lots 4 and 10, the SE/4 SW/4 and SW/4 SE/4 (S/2 S/2 equivalent) of Section 19 and Lots 1, 5, 6 and 7, the W/2 NE/4 and E/2 NW/4 (N/2 equivalent) of Section 30, both in Township 29 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, forming a non-standard 407.56-acre gas spacing and proration unit. Said unit is to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard coal gas well location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of said Section 30.

(3) By letter dated November 6, 1992, the applicant requested this case be dismissed.

(4) The applicant's request for dismissal should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

Case No. 10579 is hereby dismissed.
