**APPLICATION OF COLLINS AND WARE  
INC. FOR AN UNORTHODOX GAS WELL  
LOCATION, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.**

**ORDER OF THE DIVISION**

**BY THE DIVISION:**

This cause came on for hearing at 8:15 a.m. on August 12, 1993, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner David R. Catanach.

NOW, on this 19th day of August, 1993, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

**FINDS THAT:**

(1) Due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) The applicant, Collins and Ware, Inc., seeks approval to drill its Kaiser State Well No. 43 at an unorthodox gas well location 1000 feet from the South line and 400 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to a depth of approximately 3,850 feet to test all formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre gas spacing.

(3) The applicant proposes to dedicate the SW/4 of Section 13 to the above-described well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.

(4) Applicant's evidence and testimony indicate that the primary target within the subject well is the Wilson Yates-Seven Rivers Associated Pool.



**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:**

(1) The applicant, Collins and Ware, Inc., is hereby authorized to drill its Kaiser State Well No. 43 at an unorthodox gas well location 1000 feet from the South line and 400 feet from the West line (Unit M) of Section 13, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to a depth of approximately 3,850 feet to test all formations and/or pools developed on 160-acre gas spacing.

(2) The SW/4 of Section 13 shall be dedicated to the above-described well forming a standard 160-acre gas spacing and proration unit.


(3) In the event the above-described well is completed in the Wilson Yates-Seven Rivers Associated Pool, the applicant is hereby further authorized to simultaneously dedicate the SW/4 of Section 13 to the Kaiser State Well No. 43 and to the existing Kaiser State Well Nos. 10 and 14 located, respectively, in Units N and L.

(4) The gas allowable assigned to the subject proration unit in the Wilson Yates-Seven Rivers Associated Pool may be produced from any of the aforesaid wells in any proportion.

(5) Jurisdiction is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
