ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION

This matter came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico, at
10 o'clock A.M. on March 20, 1951, and the Commission having heard
the testimony adduced and reviewed the pertinent office records,

FINDS:

1. That the public notice having been given in compliance with
law, the Commission has jurisdiction of the interested parties and the
subject matter herein.

2. That on March 25, 1950, upon the recommendation
of the then governing jurisdiction, the Mining Mineral Lands Committee,
there was, by Commission Order No. 214, duly established a pool classified
as a gas pool designated as the Largo (Mesa Verde) pool described as:

3. That testimony adduced at the hearing, upon Byrd-Front, Inc.'s
application in this case, shows that within the confines of the proposed
extension of boundaries, and since the establishment of such Largo (Mesa Verde)
pool, producing wells have been completed in:

SW 1/4 Section 17 (Public R. Land)

NE 1/4 Section 22 (U. S. Reclaim. No. 1)

T. 23 N., R. 6 W.
NW 1/4 Section 22

all producing from Oil-22 Water and/or Oil-1 Leach in the Mesa Verde formation.

4. That applicant testimony in that it is presently completing

 SW 1/4 Section 27 (T. 22 N., R. 3 W., Sec. 27), in the Mesaville formation, and have made locations, with notice of filing of encumbering Mesaville production, as follows:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the boundaries of the Large Pool, heretofore created by Order No. 214, effective April 25, 1956, be and the same hereby are extended to include within the original boundaries of:

but in addition thereto, the following lands:

 West Sections 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12
 Sections 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20,
 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28,
 29 and 30

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That the acreage within for the pool as hereby established be and the same hereby is fixed as 320 acres for Mesaville production, and with similar locations in the sections of the respective north-east quarter and the southeast quarter of each included section, with a 320-acre balance. No other locations may be authorized after notice of leasing, upon proper applications duly filed with the Commission, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this case be retained by the Commission for the purpose of changing by reducing or extending the designated area and for other pertinent purposes as facts may be further disclosed by exploration and development.
