ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the 24th day of April 1951. The Commission having heard the evidence presented,

FINDS:

1. It has jurisdiction of this case and the parties interested therein, due notice of this hearing having been given.

2. The several areas hereinafter described each comprise a separate common reservoir of oil in the producing horizons designated and are each oil pools:
