

Spill calculations: The operator gauged the pit at the Rincon 156M. The pit contained 70 bbl of produced water. The operator called a trucking company to pull the pit. When the truck driver arrived on location to pull the pit, the driver noticed produced water leaking from the bottom of the pit. The truck pulled the water remaining in the pit. The rotor gauge on the truck indicated 62 bbls of produced water was loaded onto the truck.

70 bbl tank volume minus the 62 bbl loaded onto the truck = 8 bbl released into secondary containment

Enduring Resources had a release at the Rincon Unit 156M (**API: 30-043-21308, Sec: 16, Twn: 27N, Rge: 6W, Lat: 36.572437, Long: -107.465615**) yesterday evening at approximately 4:30pm. When the truck arrived to pull the pit, the driver noticed the pit was leaking. The truck driver pulled the pit dry, loading approximately 62 bbl of water into the truck. The pit tank has been isolated from the system. The volume released into the secondary containment is estimated at 8 bbl.
