For this event, this operator could not have reasonably anticipated the current event and it was beyond this operator's control	True
Please explain reason for why this event was beyond this operator's control	Compressor venting due to apparent failure of rod packing. Leak noticed from Bridger fly-over alert. Chevron was notified of a methane plume by a third party. After analysis, Chevron discovered that it was an emission event on 9/12/2025. The event start date and time was 09/04/2025 at 7:30 am MST. The event end date and time was 9/11/2025 at 1:42 pm MST. The intermittent event duration was 164.2 hours. A C-129A was submitted due to a revision of the emission calculation that incorporated the most current data from the operator's inspection report. Based on the updated emission volume and duration, the daily duration was less than 50 MSCF.
Steps taken to limit the duration and magnitude of vent or flare	Compressor unit was shut down upon discovery of venting emissions. Contract rental company has been contacted to make repairs. All of the facilities and emissions control devices at this site are operating as designed and, where applicable, are authorized. Chevron field personnel will execute practicable measures to minimize emissions.
Corrective actions taken to eliminate the cause and reoccurrence of vent or flare	Corrective measures focused on reducing gas emissions as quickly and safely as possible to minimize the duration and volume of gas vented
