Dear Mr. Billings:

Targa Midstream Service LP (Targa) has prepared this Final Closure Report (1RP-2227) for the July 14, 2009 produced liquids release due to a pinhole leak in a 4-inch discharge line at the Eunice South Booster Station in Lea County, New Mexico. As discussed in the February 20, 2019 meeting between Targa representatives and the OCD, Targa was able to locate the initial C141 and November 2010 photos, but no additional information on the release assessment or remediation activities has been located. This documentation is attached and a Final C141 has been prepared. Free liquid and impacted soil were reportedly removed, 100 cubic yards of impacted soil was transported to an approved landfarm, and reportedly the area was remediated to NMOCD guidelines. The area is within the operational compressor station and the release occurred over 10 years ago. Therefore, closure of 1RP-2227 is requested.

Pin-hole in 4" discharge line coming off an intake scrubber with 12# pressure. Approximately 30 feet of 4" pipe and fittings were replaced. Liquids were picked up by vacuum truck, soil scraped and transported to an NMOCD approved landfarm.

Free liquid and impacted soil were removed, 100 yards of impacted soil transported to an NMOCD approved landfarm. Reportedly, the area was remediated to NMOCD guidelines. No report is available to submit, but the area is within an operational compressor station and the release occurred over 10 years ago.

I hereby certify that the information given above is true and complete to the best of my knowledge and understand that pursuant to NMOCD rules and regulations all operators are required to report and/or file certain release notifications and perform corrective actions for releases which may endanger public health or the environment. Thank you. No problem, Targa appreciates your assistance in reviewing and closing out these historic sites.

If you recall from our Sept. 2019 submittal, 1RP-1617 was a fire with no liquid loss reported. The final signed C141 for this is attached to close out the incident.

In addition, Targa submitted a Stage II Plan for our Monument Gas Plant with cover letter back in February. I wanted to follow up to see if you had a chance to review or have any questions. We are in the process of scheduling another groundwater sampling event, but would appreciate concurrence on next steps for this site.
