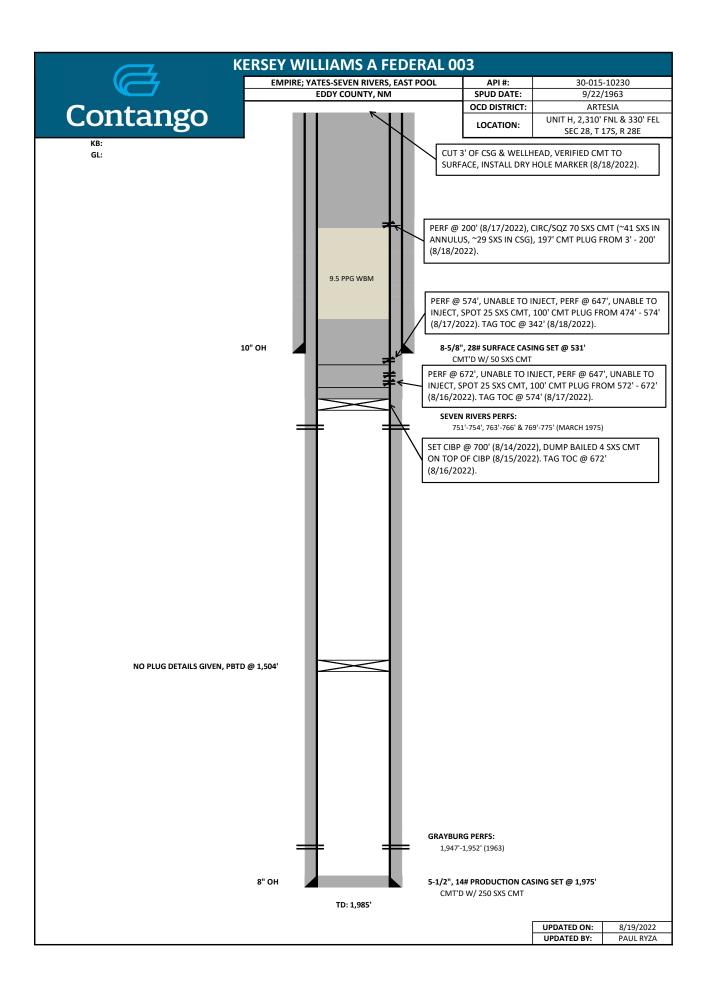

- 3. Ran CBL from 1,498' 720', unable to log above fluid level @ 750', unable to load well. Set 5-1/2" CIBP @ 700' (8/14/2022).
- 4. Dump bailed 4 sxs cmt on top of CIBP. WOC for 4 hours, tagged cmt, cmt was not set up yet (8/15/2022).
