Additional Remarks

EOG, as operator, has prioritized the development in the Wolfcamp formation and delayed development of the Leonard and Bone Spring formations. The simultaneous development and production of all formations would exceed infrastructure capacities potentially resulting in the need to flare gas and/or truck oil and water. Furthermore, recent well results elsewhere in the region suggest that optimal development of the Leonard and Bone Spring formations for maximum recovery and avoidance of waste will require supplemental permits.

We plan to drill these wells on 7/1/24.
