Colgate Operating, LLC respectfully requests an extension to the Uluru 35 Federal State Com 201H (30-015-49654) APD. The reason this well was not drilled within the first two years of approval is due to a merger in the later part of 2022 that caused significant changes to the drill schedule. The need by date is May 1, 2024.

CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL FOR APD EXTENSION

The Approved Application for Permit to Drill (AAPD) expires if only conductor or surface casing has been set, and the well is not being diligently drilled at the expiration date of the extension.

The APD extension is granted for a 2-year period, not exceed 4 years from the approval of the APD.
