Procedure Description: Ameredev would like to request the removal of the DV Tool on the intermediate casing string. In the event that cement is not circulated back to surface on the Intermediate string, Ameredev will run a temperature survey to confirm TOC. If TOC is tied back to the surface casing (i.e. cased hole), Ameredev proposes to continue with operations. If TOC is in open hole, Ameredev proposes to remediate by performing a Bradenhead squeeze. The Capitan Reef is identified as the loss circulation zone; during the Bradenhead squeeze, the Salado, Tansill, and Capitan Reef might be open depending on TOC. The squeeze will be performed against the Lamar and TOC.
