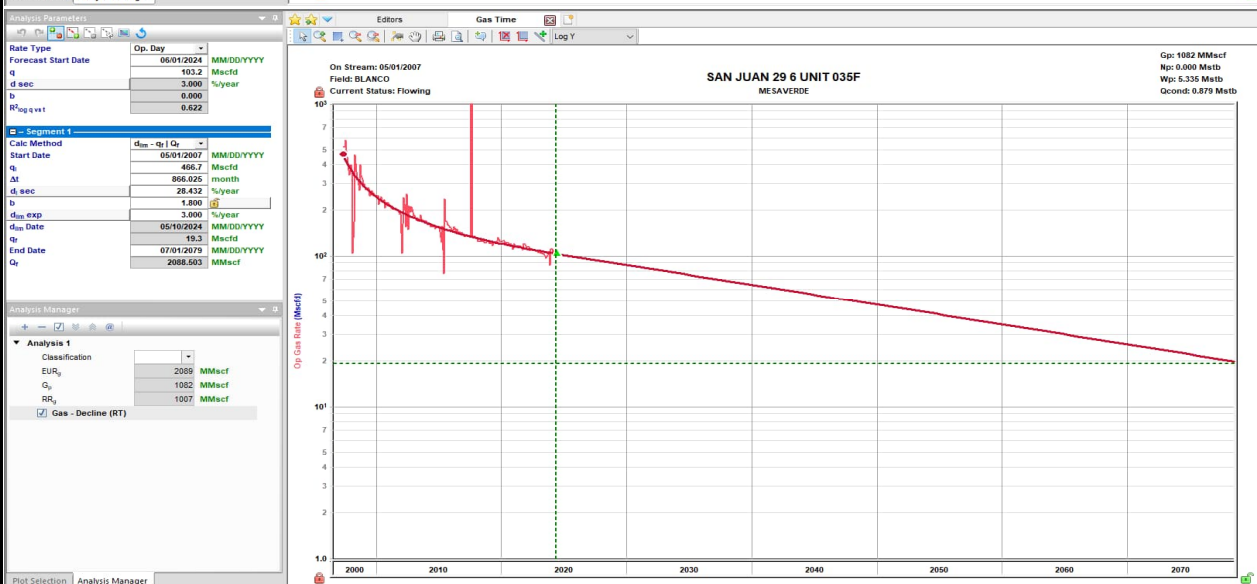
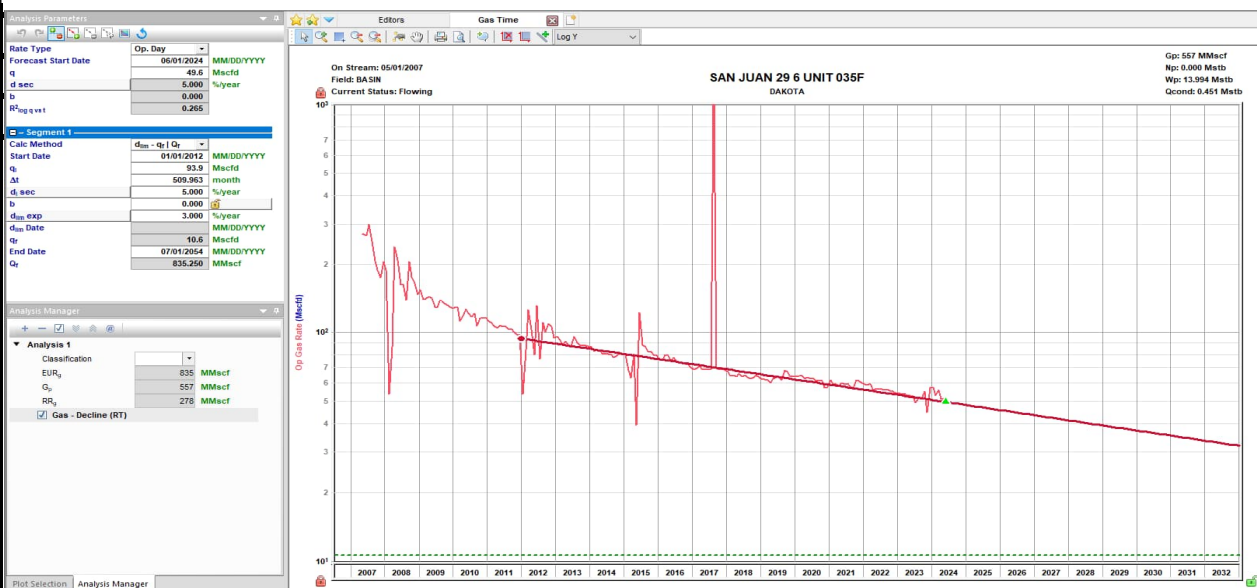

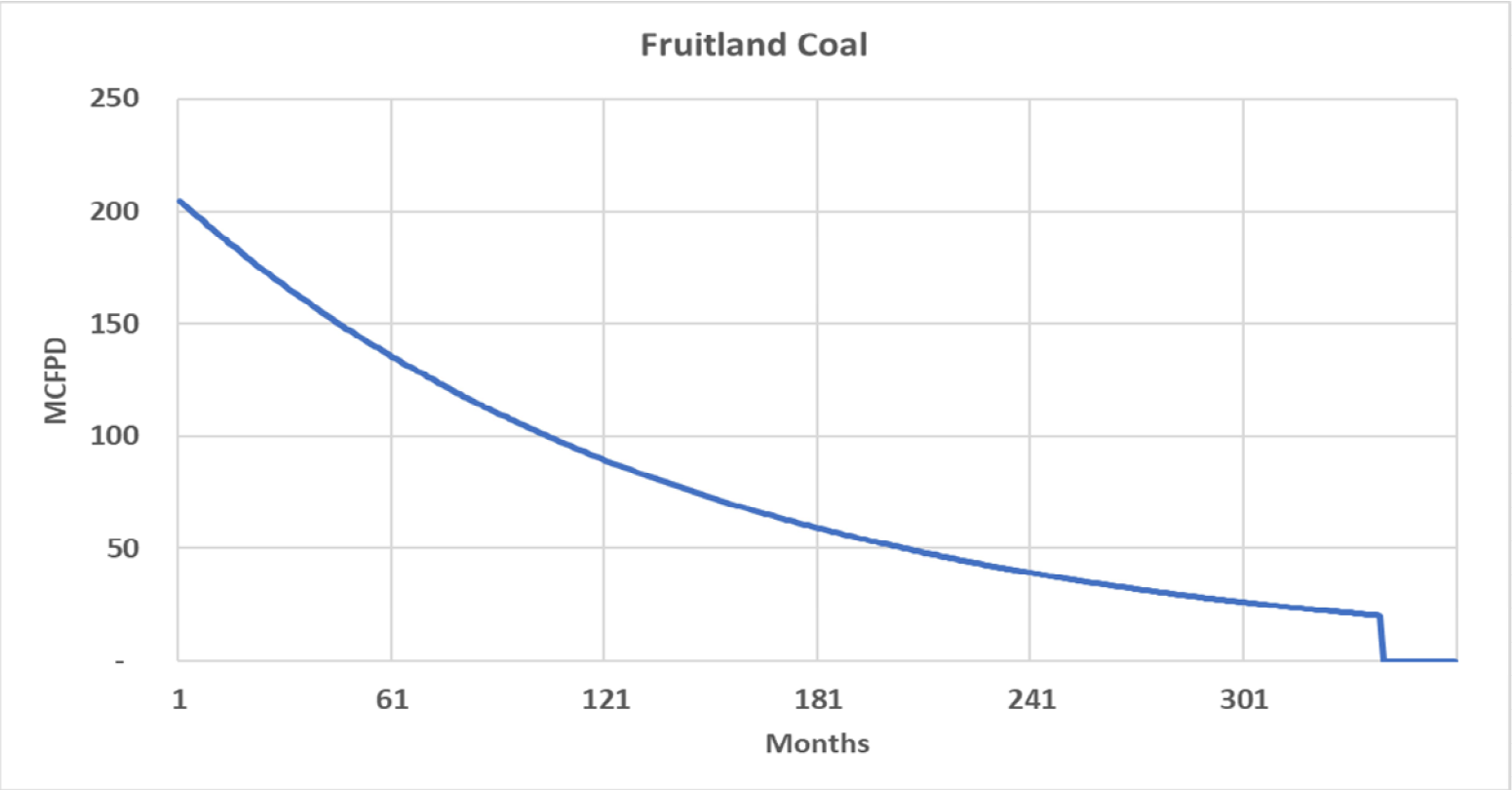
Gas Allocation:

Production for the downhole commingle will be allocated using the subtraction method in agreement with local agencies. The base formations are the Mesaverde and Dakota. The added formation to be commingled is the Fruitland Coal. The subtraction method applies an average monthly production forecast to the base formation using historic production. All production from this well exceeding the forecast will be allocated to the new formation.

After 3 years production will stabilize. A production average will be gathered during the 4th year and will be utilized to create a fixed percentage based allocation.



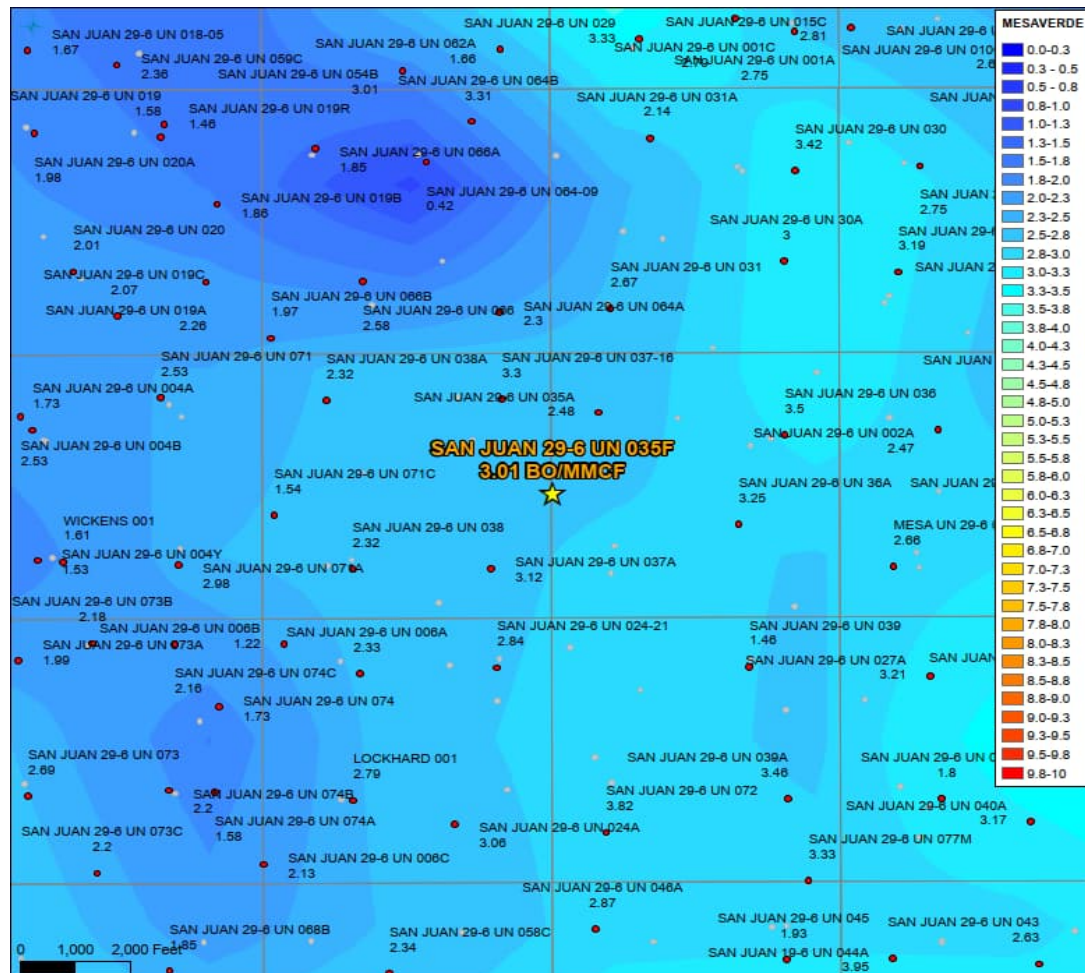
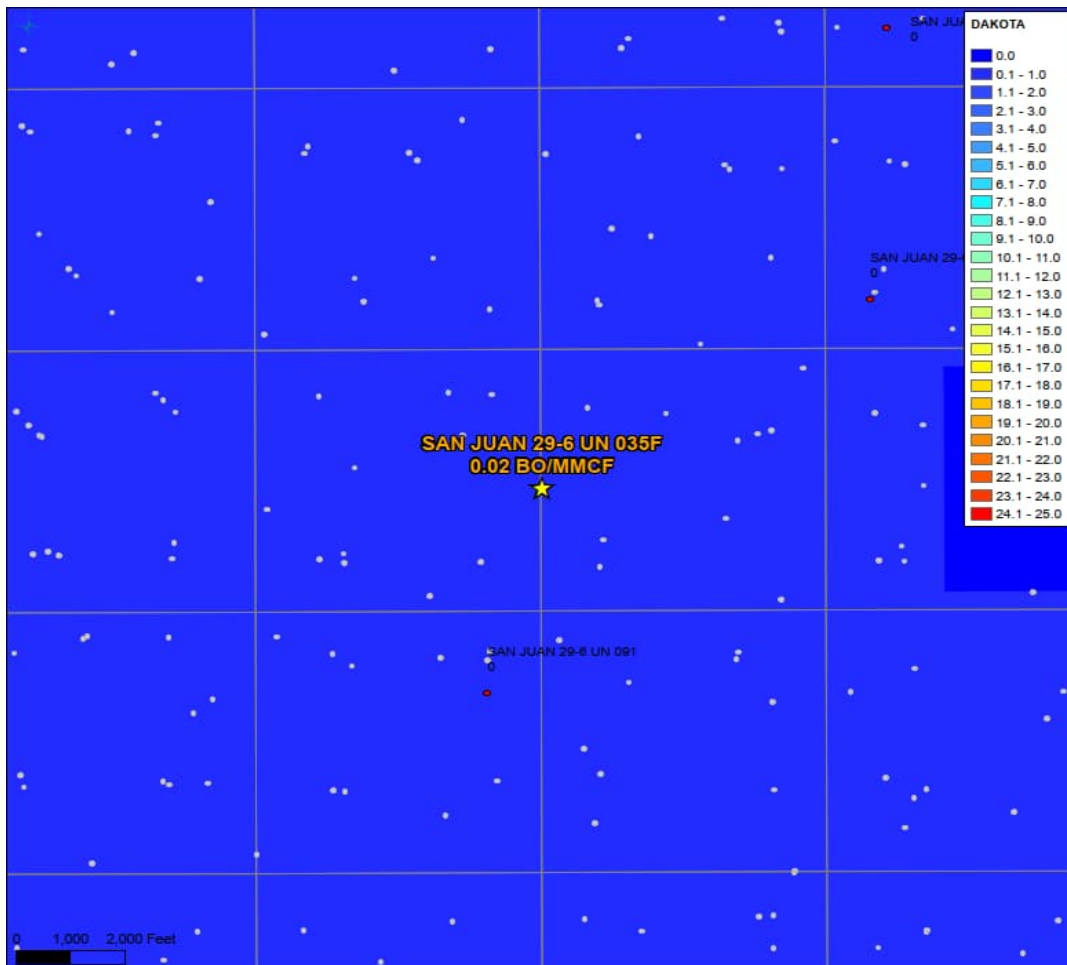


Oil Allocation:
