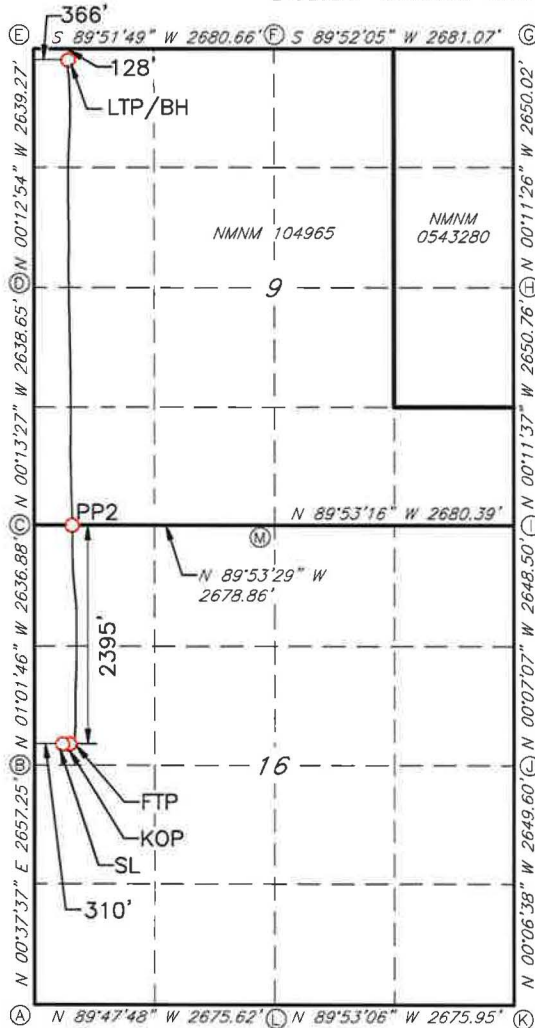

ACREAGE DEDICATION PLATS
