This office has received and reviewed your designation of successor unit operator in which your company has agreed to assume all rights, duties, and obligations as the unit operator of the North Benson Queen Unit Eddy County, New Mexico.

As your company as Linn Operating, Inc. has obtained a Nationwide 250,000.00 BLM Bond (NMB000501) with a rider however, a recommendation has been sent to BLM New Mexico State Office to require that Linn Operating, Inc. to post an additional individual Unit bond in the amount of \$50,000.00. The Authorized Officer condition of approval is based upon Linn Operating, Inc. final bonding to be in place within 60 days of the date of this letter.

Therefore, Linn Operating, Inc. is hereby approved as the unit operator for the North Benson Queen Unit as of this date and is effective April 1, 2011. In accordance with this approval, Linn Operating, Inc. is responsible for all operations and the reporting of all production from the unit. Well signs should also reflect Linn Operating, Inc. as the unit operator. Please inform all interested principles of such approval. An approved copy of this designation is enclosed.

In approving this designation, the Authorized Officer neither warrants nor certifies that the designated party has obtained all required approvals that would entitle it to conduct operations under the North Benson Queen Unit Agreement.

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In addition to becoming the successor unit operator, this office requests a 2012 Plan of Development and a revised Exhibit B for the subject unit within 60 days from the receipt of this letter.

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Act of February 25, 1920, 41 Stat. 437, 30 U.S.C. Secs. 181, et seq., as amended by the Act of August 8, 1946, 60 Stat. 950, the Secretary of the Interior, acting by and through the Authorized Officer, on the 10th day of January, 1973, approved a Unit Agreement for North Benson Queen Unit Area, wherein SandRidge Exploration and Production, LLC was designated as Unit Operator, and

WHEREAS, SandRidge Exploration and Production, LLC desires to resign as such Operator and the designation of a successor Unit Operator is now required pursuant to the terms thereof; and
