Dear Mr. Frohnepfel:

Our records reflect that Chesapeake Operating, Inc. is the operator of record for the Kemnitz Lower Wolfcamp East Unit, Lea County, New Mexico.

Article 18.1, TERM of the agreement provides that: The term of this agreement shall be for the time that Unitized Substances are produced in paying quantities and as long thereafter as Unit Operations are conducted without a cessation of more than ninety (90) consecutive days, unless sooner terminated by Working Interest Owners in the manner herein provided.

Our records reflect the following:

- The Kemnitz Lower Wolfcamp East Unit Well No. 2-K Sec. 22-16S-34E was plugged and abandoned on 10/31/2007.
- The Kemnitz Lower Wolfcamp East Unit Well No. 3-O Sec. 22-16S-34E was plugged and abandoned on 12/8/2007.
- The Kemnitz Lower Wolfcamp East Unit Well No. 4-A Sec. 28-16S-34E was plugged and abandoned on 3/12/2008.
- The Kemnitz Lower Wolfcamp East Unit Well No. 5-C Sec. 27-16S-34E was plugged and abandoned on 4/15/2008.
- The Kemnitz Lower Wolfcamp East Unit Well No. 6-M Sec. 22-16S-34E was plugged and abandoned on 3/17/2008.

Please be advised that since all wells in the Kemnitz Lower Wolfcamp East Unit Agreement have been plugged and abandoned the Unit Agreement has this date been terminated effective April 15, 2008 being the date the last unit well was plugged and abandoned.
