Gentlemen:

Communitization Agreement NM109706 was approved 8/19/2003, effective as of 5/12/2003. This agreement communitized the E2 of sec. 34, T. 21 S., R. 24 E., NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico involving 80 acres of Fee land, and 240.00 acres of Federal land in lease NMNM53218 which comprise a 320.00 acre well spacing unit as to natural gas and associated liquid hydrocarbons producible from the Cisco and Canyon formations.

The term of the agreement is for two years and so long thereafter as communitized substances are or can be produced from the communitized area in paying quantities.

Our records show that the well, Righthand Canyon 34 Fed Com 5, 3001532588, in the above-described communitized spacing unit, NMNM109706, under the E2 of sec. 34, T. 21 S., R. 24 E., NMPM, produced from the Penn Upper formation. The Penn Upper formation was plugged and abandoned effective 1/24/14.

Accordingly, in the absence of a well capable of producing communitized substances in paying quantities, CA NMNM109706 is considered to have expired by its own terms as of 1/31/2014, the last day of the month in which the well was plugged and abandoned. Lease NMNM53218 is eligible for a two year extension ending 1/31/2016, pursuant to 43 CFR 3107.4 as a result of the termination of the subject agreement. Lease NMNM53218 is held by other production.
