Enclosed is an approved copy of Communitization Agreement NM135905 involving 160 acres of Federal land in lease NMNM99039, 80 acres of Federal land in lease NMNM130869 and 80 acres of Federal land in lease NMNM23002, Eddy County, New Mexico, which comprise a 320 acre well spacing unit.

The agreement communitizes all rights to all producible hydrocarbons from the Bone Spring formation beneath T. 19 S., R. 31 E., N2 of Sec. 11, NMPM, and is effective 07/01/2014. Approval of this agreement does not warrant or certify that the operator, thereof, and other working interest owners hold legal or equitable title to the leases which are committed here to. This agreement is to replace the existing communitization agreement NM134540 in order to solve drainage issues. Therefore when CA NM134540 is terminated, you will be required to resubmit all production to the new agreement, NM135905.

Approval of this agreement does not constitute an adjudication of any state, local government, or private interests, and does not constitute a warranty or certification that the information supplied by the party submitting this agreement regarding any private, state, or local government interests is accurate.

Any production royalties that are due must be reported and paid according to regulations set up by the Office of Natural Resources Revenue at 1-800-525-9167 or 303-231-3504.
