
Communitization Agreement (CA) NM130318 was approved May 3, 2013, effective as of March 1, 2013. This agreement communitized the E2E2 of Section 33-T. 23 S., R. 29 E., NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico involving 80 acres of Federal land in lease NM86024 and 80 of Federal land in lease NM19848 comprising a 160 acre well spacing unit as to all rights to all producible hydrocarbons from the Bone Spring formation.

This well is currently being reported under an established 160 acre well spacing. Due to drainage caused from the drilling of other wells within this spacing, the agreement was created using the wrong spacing. Therefore, per operator request, this CA NM130318 is hereby terminated effective March 1, 2013 and will be replaced by CA NM135945. All production currently on the terminated agreement CA NM130318 will need to be resubmitted to the new CA NM135945 from March 2013 forward.

All leases within the CA are eligible for a two year extension, pursuant to 43 CFR 3107.4 as a result of the termination of the subject agreement. However, the leases are currently held by production and are now committed to CA NM135945.
