RE: 2017 Plan of Development Outland Unit Lea County, NM

Dear Ms. Allen:

The New Mexico Commissioner of Public Lands has this date approved the referenced Plan of Development. Our approval is subject to like approval by all relevant agencies. We may contact you at a later date regarding the following:

- The possibility of drainage by wells outside the unit area, and
- A need for further development of the unit.

In addition, we have noted that production for this unit has been progressively declining over the past five years. This decline concerns us. In the approval letter for the Outland Unit 2016 Plan of Development we requested a review of the Bone Spring horizontal potential with the idea that unit production could be improved. This request was not fulfilled in the 2017 Plan of Development.

We again request an evaluation of the Bone Spring horizontal potential for Outland Unit, as well as other considerations for improving unit production. We suggest this be submitted as a supplement to the 2017 Plan of Development.

Your <u>2018 Plan of Development</u> should include (1) a continuing evaluation of the possibility of additional resource production within the unit, and (2) a map that illustrates both current and planned unit infrastructure: well locations, tank batteries, gathering systems, and any other facilities that may impact the surface of New Mexico State Trust lands.

- 3. All ratifications from the Lessees of Record and Working Interest Owners. All signatures should be acknowledged by a notary and contain original signatures.
- Approval order from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division. State Land Office approval is conditioned upon approval by the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division.

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- 5. One copy of the Unit Operating Agreement (if applicable).
- 6. A \$1,500 filing fee. The filing fee is \$100 for each section or partial section included in the unit, whether federal, state, or privately owned.
