#### Gentlemen:

On June 5, 2018 we sent you a letter stating that we were in the process of reviewing the above referenced communitization agreement (CA) which was recently submitted by XTO Energy, INC., the CA operator. We were notified by the CA operator that they had been unable to obtain a signature from you committing your interest as a record title owner in the communitized area that would allow the BLM to approve the proposed CA. You are listed as a record title owner for Federal Oil and Gas Lease No. NMNM35607 (Tract 1) which is part of the proposed CA.

Section 4 of your lease terms for Lease No. NMNM35607 states that the lessor reserves the right to specify rates of development and production in the public interest and to require the lessee (record title owner) to subscribe to a cooperative or unit plan, within 30 days of notice, if deemed necessary for proper development and operation embracing the leased lands. We have determined that it is in the best interest of the Federal government to approve the proposed CA.

Our records indicate you failed to respond to our letter dated June 5, 2018. As a result, we hereby commit your record title interest in Lease No. NMNM35607 to CA No. NMNM137976,

effective October 13, 2016, (the effective date of the CA), in accordance with the terms and provisions of Lease No. NMNM35607.

This decision may be appealed in accordance with 43 CFR-3165.3(b).

#### Gentlemen:

This letter is for the <u>final approval</u> of the Communitization Agreement NMNM137976 involving 120 acres of Federal land in lease NMNM35607, 40 acres of Federal land in lease NMNM41646 and 63.97 acres of State land, Eddy County, New Mexico, which comprise a 223.97 acre well spacing unit. Final approval has been granted and final force pool letters have been mailed to the lessees of record that XTO Energy, Inc. and Bureau of Land Wianagement Carlsbad Field Office were unable to locate. A copy of this letter is included.

The agreement communitizes all rights to all producible hydrocarbons from the Wolfcamp formation beneath Sec. 25, W2 and Sec. 36, NW, T. 26 S., R. 29 E., NMPM, Eddy County, NM, and is effective 11/13/2016. Approval of this agreement does not constitute an adjudication of any state, local government, or private interests, and does not constitute a warranty or certification that the information supplied by the party submitting this agreement regarding any private, state, or local government interests is accurate.

Copies of this approval letter are being distributed to the appropriate Federal agencies. You are requested to furnish all interested parties with the appropriate evidence of this approval. Any production royalties that are due must be reported and paid according to regulations set up by the Office of Natural Resources Revenue at 1-800-525-9167 or 303-231-3504.

## Determination - Approval - Certification

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Secretary of the Interior under Section 17(j) of the Mineral Leasing Act of 1920, as amended (74 Stat. 784; 30 U.S.C. 226(j)), and delegated to the authorized officer of the Bureau of Land Management, I do hereby:

- Determine that the Federal lease or leases as to the lands committed to the attached A. agreement cannot be independently developed and operated in conformity with the well-spacing program established for the field or area in which said lands are located, and that consummation and approval of the agreement will be in the public interest. Approval of this agreement does not warrant or certify that the operator thereof and other holders of operating rights hold legal or equitable title to those rights in the subject leases which are committed hereto.
- B. Approve the attached Communitization Agreement covering sec. 25, W2 and sec. 36, NW, T. 26 S., R. 29 E., NMPM, as to all producible hydrocarbons from the Wolfcamp formation. This approval will become invalid if the public interest requirements under section 3105.2-3 (c) are not met.
