We have determined that the Laguna Grande Unit No. 7H well is capable of producing unitized substances from the Wolfcamp Formation in paying quantities as defined in Section 9 of the unit agreement. This well was completed in the Wolfcamp Formation on April 20, 2018.

Consequently, an application for an initial Wolfcamp Formation Participating Area "A" shall be filed with the Reservoir Management Group pursuant to Section 11 of the unit agreement by April 19, 2019. The effective date for this PA will be April 20, 2018.
