Now on to the -- that was -- those are all the continued cases. Now to the dismissals.

The following cases are dismissed: Cases Number 20217, 20218, 20219, 20276, 20277, 20278, 20412, 20524, 20525, 20526, and 20758, 20759 were all cases that are dismissed.

MS. MARLENE SALVIDREZ: May I make a correction? Page 1, Number 5 on the docket, 16489 should be would be continued to October 31st.

EXAMINER LOWE: Okay.
MS. MARLENE SALVIDREZ: And then
page $55--$ I mean, Number 55 on the docket page 5, 20676 October 31st.

EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. Thank you, Marlene.
On that note we will continue with -- we will start off with --

MS. BENNETT: Mr. Examiner, I do have a quick question on Cases Number 29 and 30 on the docket, and I think I may have just missed those as you reading through. My notes show that those should have been
continued.

Did you happen to read those off when you read the continuances?

EXAMINER LOWE: Yes.
MS. BENNETT: Okay. Thank you.
MR. ADAM RANKIN: Mr. Examiner, Adam Rankin with Holland \& Hart. Mr. Examiner, on Case Number 1 on the docket, Case Number 13987, as of yesterday we were intending to put this case on. I got a call from the client indicating they had found additional parties who had not received notice. They have been searching their ownership records since the September 19th hearing, and they did find some yesterday.

So, as consequence, while we were
intending to put the case on today, we have to continue it until January $23 r d$ so that we can perfect notice to those additional parties. So, we filed an application for continuance yesterday as soon as we found out, and we ask that that case be continued to the 23 rd so we can perfect notice.

EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. We will inquire with Marlene about that.

MR. ADAM RANKIN: Well, pursuant to the rules -- the reason for the continuance arose after the
deadline. And so the rule says continuance may be filed if the reason for the continuance comes up after the deadline, which in this case it did.

And so we're asking that the case be continued. It's -- nobody's prejudiced. There's no other parties in the matter. And so I think it makes sense. It's more efficient to just continue the case and perfect notice and present the affidavit on the $23 r d$ of January.

EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. We'll try to work on that on our side.

MR. ADAM RANKIN: Okay. Thank you.
EXAMINER GOETZE: Just a comment. And it wasn't until yesterday that we still did not have information of notice?

MR. ADAM RANKIN: That is correct.

EXAMINER GOETZE: And these are the land people?

MR. ADAM RANKIN: Yes, that is correct.
EXAMINER GOETZE: Okay. Well, just they've been working on this since September.

MR. ADAM RANKIN: I understand. I agree. I agree.

EXAMINER GOETZE: Okay. Just so noted.
EXAMINER LOWE: Okay. Do you have any

1 more questions? Any questions?

MS. MARLENE SALVIDREZ: No. Just on that note, we've been dismissing those. So, I need to talk to management on that.

EXAMINER LOWE: We'll get with you on that.
