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## **APPLICATION**

Matador Production Company ("Matador" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a standard 640-acre, more or less, horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 of Section 35, Township 22 South, Range 28 East, and the W/2 of Section 2, Township 23 South, Range 28 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. In support of its application, Matador states:

- 1. An affiliate entity of Matador (OGRID No. 228937) is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant seeks to dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the following proposed initial well:
  - Gladiator Fed Com #121H well and Gladiator Fed Com #135H well to be horizontally drilled from a common surface location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 35, to bottom hole locations in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 2; and
  - Gladiator Fed Com #122H well to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 35, to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 2.

- 3. The completed interval for the proposed **Gladiator Fed Com #135H well** will be within 330' of the quarter-quarter line separating the W/2 W/2 and the E/2 W/2 of Sections 35 and 2 to allow inclusion of this acreage into a standard 640-acre horizontal well spacing unit.
- 4. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all of the working interest owners in the subject spacing unit.
- 5. The pooling of interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.
- 6. In order to permit Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all uncommitted interests in this horizontal spacing unit should be pooled, and Applicant should be designated the operator of the proposed horizontal wells and this horizontal spacing unit.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on October 7, 2020, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the horizontal spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation and approving the initial wells thereon;
- B. Designating Applicant as operator of this spacing unit and the horizontal wells to be drilled thereon;
- C. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping, and completing the wells;
- D. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and

E. Imposing a 200% charge for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the wells.
