Spur Energy Partners, LLC (“Spur”) (OGRID No. 328947), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend Order Nos. R-20642, R-20642-B and R-20642-C (“Orders”) for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Orders. In support of its application, Spur states:

1. Division Order No. R-20642, entered June 24, 2019, in Case No. 20191, created a 200-acre, more or less, standard horizontal oil spacing unit in the Penasco Draw; San Andres Yeso Pool (50270) underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 28, and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (the “Unit”). An affiliate entity of Spur is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
2. The Order limited the pooled vertical depths from a stratigraphic equivalent of the top of the San Andres-Yeso formation at 2279 feet measured depth to a depth of 3,200 feet, as defined in the Gamma Ray-Neutron Log from the Len Mayer 1 Well (API No. 30-015-05926). The Order dedicated the spacing unit, subject to the pooled vertical limits, to the proposed initial **Nirvana #1H well** to be drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 29.

3. Division Order No. R-20642-B, entered on July 22, 2020, in Case No. 21254, added the **Nirvana #2H well**, to be drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 29, to the approved spacing unit pooled under the terms of Order No. R-20642.

4. Division Order No. R-20642-C, entered on January 19, 2021, in Case No. 21581, pooled additional interest owners under the terms of Order Nos. R-20642 and R-20642-B.

5. Spur requests that the Orders be re-opened and amended to allow Spur additional time to commence drilling the well under the Orders.

6. There is good cause for Spur's request for an extension of time to drill. Specifically, the decline in commodity prices in 2020 caused by the global COVID pandemic and other economic factors led to Spur reducing its rig count, thereby causing Spur to delay its intended plans to develop the acreage subject to the Orders.

7. Under the Orders, Spur would be required to commence drilling the well by June 30, 2021, and therefore, asks for the deadline to commence drilling the well be extended for a year, to June 30, 2022.

WHEREFORE, Spur requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on June 3, 2021, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order extending the time for Spur to commence drilling the proposed initial well under the Orders.

Spur Energy Partners, LLC (“Spur”) (OGRID No. 328947), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend Order Nos. R-20643 and R-20643-A (“Orders”) for an extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Orders. In support of its application, Spur states:

1. Division Order No. R-20643, entered June 24, 2019, in Case No. 20263, created a 200-acre, more or less, standard horizontal oil spacing unit in the Penasco Draw; San Andres Yeso Pool (50270) underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 28, and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (the “Unit”). An affiliate entity of Spur is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
2. The Order limited the pooled vertical depths from a stratigraphic equivalent of a depth of 3,201 feet to the base of the Yeso formation at a stratigraphic equivalent of 4,460 feet measured depth, as defined in the Gamma Ray-Neutron Log from the Len Mayer 1 Well (API No. 30-015-05926). The Order dedicated the spacing unit, subject to the pooled vertical limits, to the proposed initial **Nirvana #3H well** to be drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 29.
3. Division Order No. R-20643-A, entered on January 19, 2021, in Case No. 21582, pooled additional interest owners under the terms of Order No. R-20643.

4. Spur requests that the Orders be re-opened and amended to allow Spur additional time to commence drilling the well under the Orders.

5. There is good cause for Spur's request for an extension of time to drill. Specifically, the decline in commodity prices in 2020 caused by the global COVID pandemic and other economic factors led to Spur reducing its rig count, thereby causing Spur to delay its intended plans to develop the acreage subject to the Orders.

**AFFIDAVIT OF MEGAN PEÑA
IN SUPPORT OF CASE NO. 21918**

Megan Peña, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

1. My name is Megan Peña. I work for Spur Energy Partners, LLC (“Spur”), as a Senior Landman.
2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.
3. I am familiar with the application filed by Spur in this case and the lands involved.
4. None of the mineral owners to be pooled have expressed opposition to this case proceeding by affidavit, so I do not expect any opposition at the hearing.
5. In **Case No. 21938**, Spur seeks to amend Order Nos. R-20642, R-20642-B and R-20642-C for a year extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Orders.
6. Under Case No. 20191, the Division entered Order No. R-20642, on June 24, 2019.

This Order created a standard 200-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 S/2 of Section

28, and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

7. Order Nos. R-20642 and R-20642-B limited the pooled vertical depths from a stratigraphic equivalent of the top of the San Andres-Yeso formation at 2279 feet measured depth to a depth of 3,200 feet, as defined in the Gamma Ray-Neutron Log from the Len Mayer 1 Well (API No. 30-015-05926). The Order dedicated the spacing unit, subject to the pooled vertical limits, to the proposed initial **Nirvana #1H well** to be drilled from a surface location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 27, to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 29. Division Order No. R-20642-B, entered on July 22, 2020, in Case No. 21254, added the **Nirvana #2H well** to this approved spacing unit.

8. Division Order No. R-20642-C, entered on January 19, 2021, in Case No. 21581, pooled additional interest owners under the terms of Order Nos. R-20642 and R-20642-B.

9. In **Case No. 21939**, Spur seeks to amend Order Nos. R-20643 and R-20643-A for a year extension of time for drilling the proposed initial well under the Orders.

10. Under Case No. 20263, the Division entered Order No. R-20643, on June 24, 2019. The Order created a standard 200 acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit in the S/2 S/2 of Section 28, and the SE/4 SE/4 of Section 29, Township 18 South, Range 26 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

11. Order No. R-20643 limited the pooled vertical depths from a stratigraphic equivalent of a depth of 3,201 feet to the base of the Yeso formation at a stratigraphic equivalent of 4,460 feet measured depth, as defined in the Gamma Ray-Neutron Log from the Len Mayer 1 Well (API No. 30-015-05926). The Order dedicated the spacing unit, subject to the pooled vertical limits, to the proposed initial **Nirvana #3H well**.

12. Division Order No. R-20643-A, entered on January 19, 2021, in Case No. 21582, pooled additional interest owners under the terms of Order No. R-20643.

13. The decline in commodity prices in 2020 caused by the global COVID pandemic and other economic factors, led Spur to delay its intended plans to develop the acreage subject to the Orders.

14. The Orders in Case Nos. 21938 and 21939 required drilling to commence within a year, by June 30, 2021.

15. Spur has not yet commenced drilling the well as required by the Orders but anticipates drilling within the next year.

16. Spur therefore requests that the deadline to commence drilling under these pooling orders be extended for a year, to **June 30, 2022**.

17. Spur provided our outside counsel, Holland and Hart, with a list of the working interest owners that remain subject to each pooling order and instructed them to provide notice of this hearing to these pooled working interest owners.

18. None of the working interest owners that remain subject to these pooling orders have been asked at this time to make an election on the applicable well, or to pay their estimated share of the costs to drill, complete and equip the applicable well.
