STATEMENT OF THE CASE

APPLICANT

Case No. 22015: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2SW/4 of Section 17, the W/2W/2 of Section 20, and the W/2NW/4 of Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the North Wilson Deep Unit Well No. 3H,

with a first take point in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 17 and a last take point in the SW/4NW/4 of Section 29.

Case No. 22016: Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2SW/4 of Section 17, the E/2W/2 of Section 20, and the E/2NW/4 of Section 29, Township 21 South, Range 35 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to the North Wilson Deep Unit Well No. 4H, with a first take point in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 17 and a last take point in the SE/4NW/4 of Section 29.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a cost plus 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the wells.


