**STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

**APPLICANT**

Case No. 22035: Applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2W/2 of Section 26 and the W/2SW/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to (a) the Inland 26/23 B2ML State Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the SW/4SW/4 of 26 and a last take point in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 23, and (b) the Inland 26/23 B3ML State Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the SW/4SW/4 of 26 and a last take point in the NW/4SW/4 of Section 23.

Case No. 22036: Applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2W/2 of Section 26 and the E/2SW/4 of Section 23, Township 21 South, Range 34 East, NMPM. The unit will be dedicated to (a) the Inland 26/23 B2NK State Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point

in the SE/4SW/4 of 26 and a last take point in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 23, and (b) the Inland 26/23 B3NK State Com. Well No. 1H, with a first take point in the SE/4SW/4 of 26 and a last take point in the NE/4SW/4 of Section 23.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the wells.


