In Case No. 22156, Devon seeks an order (1) creating a standard 640-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the S/2 of Sections 25 and 26, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying said unit. Devon proposes to dedicate the HSU to its **Prairie Fire 25-26 Fed Com 333H Well**, an oil well, proposed to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in Lot 4 (SW/4 SW/4) (Unit M) of Section 30, Township 20 South, Range 30 East, NMPM, to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 26, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. The **Prairie Fire 25-26 Fed Com 333H Well** is the proximity well for the HSU.
