**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO VACATE CONTESTED HEARING**

Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne") moves the Division to vacate the contested hearing scheduled in these cases. In support thereof, Mewbourne states:


1. Mewbourne's cases were presented on October 7, 2021, and taken under advisement. Matador filed an entry of appearance in the cases on October 12, 2021 and moved the Division to re-open Mewbourne's cases. Matador also filed counter-pooling applications (Case Nos. 22257 and 22258).

2. Matador's motion to-reopen was granted, and all cases were set for a contested hearing on January 6, 2022.

3. Mewbourne and Matador have settled their differences, and Matador has dismissed its cases. Therefore there is no need for a contested hearing.

WHEREFORE, Mewbourne requests that the contested hearing be vacated, and Mewbourne's cases be taken under advisement on January 6, 2022.

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
