APPLICATION

Spur Energy Partners, LLC (“Spur” or “Applicant”) (OGRID No. 328947) through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to amend Order No. R-21583 (the “Order”) to allow for a one year extension for drilling the proposed initial well under the Order. In support of its application, Spur states:

1. Order No. R-21583, entered on January 19, 2021, in Case No. 21583, created a standard 160-acre horizontal spacing unit in a portion of the Yeso formation, from a depth of 3,001 feet to the base of the Yeso formation, underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (the “Unit”), and designated Applicant as the operator of the Unit.

2. The Unit was designated to the proposed initial (1) the Oasis #11H well, (2) the Oasis #20H well, (3) the Oasis #51H well, (4) the Oasis #71H well, and (5) the Oasis #72H well.

3. Order No. R-21583 required the drilling of the initial well by January 19, 2022.

4. There is good cause for Spur’s request that the Order be re-opened and amended to allow Spur additional time to commence drilling the well under the Order.

5. The decline in commodity prices in 2020 caused by the global COVID pandemic and other economic factors led Spur to reduce its rig count, thereby causing

Spur to delay its intended plans to develop the acreage subject to the Order. Spur anticipates being able to drill the initial well required by the Order within the next year.

AFFIDAVIT OF RETT DALTON

Rett Dalton, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

1. My name is Rett Dalton. I am a landman for Spur Energy Partners, LLC (“Spur”).
2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum land manager have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of record.
3. I am familiar with the application filed by Spur in this case, and I am familiar with the status of the lands in the subject area.
4. None of the pooled parties has indicated opposition to this extension application, and therefore I do not expect any opposition at the hearing
5. Order No. R-21583, entered on January 19, 2021, in Case No. 21583, created a standard 160-acre horizontal spacing unit in a portion of the Yeso formation, from a depth of 3,001 feet to the base of the Yeso formation, underlying the S/2 S/2 of Section 18, Township 18 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico (the “Unit”), and designated Applicant as the operator of the Unit.
6. The Unit was designated to the proposed initial (1) the Oasis #11H well, (2) the Oasis #20H well, (3) the Oasis #51H well, (4) the Oasis #71H well, and (5) the Oasis #72H well.
7. Order No. R-21583 required the drilling of the initial well by January 19, 2022.

10. Therefore, Spur requests a one-year extension of time to drill the initial well under the Order, until January 19, 2023.

11. Spur provided our outside counsel, Holland and Hart, with a list of the working interest owners that remain subject to each pooling order and instructed them to provide notice of this hearing to these pooled working interest owners.

12. None of the working interest owners that remain subject to these pooling orders have been asked at this time to make an election on the applicable well, or to pay their estimated share of the costs to drill, complete and equip the applicable well.



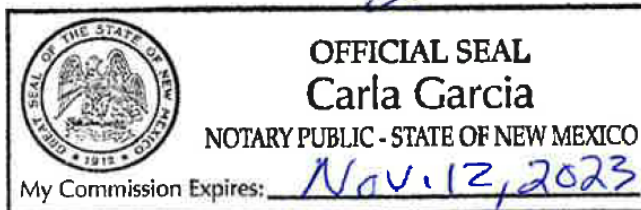


