
**UNOPPOSED MOTION TO VACATE PRE-HEARING ORDER**

Matador Production Company ("Matador") moves the Division for an order vacating the pre-hearing order in these cases, and in support thereof, states:

1. In these matters Matador and COG Operating LLC ("COG") have opposing cases seeking orders pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring and Wolfcamp formations in the lands described in the applications.
2. The cases are set for hearing, under a pre-hearing order, on January 20, 2022.
3. The parties are attempting to settle their differences, and desire additional time to discuss the issues. Motions to continue the cases have been filed by both parties.
4. As a result, Matador requests that the pre-hearing order be vacated, and request that at the January 20<sup>th</sup> hearing a status conference be held on all related applications.
