APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Manzano seeks to amend Order No. R-21572-A to modify and expand the geographic area of the Vindicator Canyon State Exploratory Unit. This Unit currently consists of approximately 6,960 acres of state lands in Lea County. Manzano has recently executed transactions in Township 17 South, Range 36 East that warrant (a) removal of the E/2 of Section 30 and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 31 from the Unit, and (b) the addition of all of Section 21 to the Unit. This will result in a net expansion of unitized area by 240-acres. The expanded Unit will now consist of approximately 7,200 acres comprised of the following state lands in Lea County:

TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, N.M.P.M.

All other aspects of the Unit and the governing Unit Agreement approved by Order R-21572 remain the same.

The New Mexico State Land Office has been contacted about this modification to the Unit and has expressed approval of this change. Approval of this modification and expansion will provide Manzano the flexibility to locate and drill wells in the Unit to maximize recovery of oil and gas from the unitized interval, thereby preventing waste, and will provide the applicant latitude to conduct operations in an effective and efficient manner within the Unit.
