1. Division Order No. R-21682, entered on May 17, 2021, in Case No. 21799, pooled all uncommitted interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a standard 320-acre horizontal spacing unit comprised of the W/2 W/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, and the W/2 W/2 of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and dedicated the unit to the proposed **Jade 34-3 Fed Com 2BS 5H** and the **Jade 34-3 Fed Com 1BS 9H** wells.

2. Paragraph 19 of Order No. R-21682 requires Applicant to commence drilling the wells “within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well.”

3. Good cause exists to extend the drilling deadline and Applicant requests that Order No. R-21682 be amended to allow an additional year to commence drilling the initial well under the Order.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on April 7, 2022, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order extending the time for Applicant to commence drilling the proposed initial wells under the Order R-21682 to May 17, 2023.



AFFIDAVIT OF LUKE SHELTON, LANDMAN

Luke Shelton, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

1. My name is Luke Shelton, and I am employed by Chisholm Energy Operating, LLC (“Chisholm”) as a Landman. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an expert witness in petroleum land matters and my credentials as a petroleum landman have been accepted by the Division and made a matter of public record.

2. I am familiar with the applications filed by Chisholm in these consolidated cases and the status of the development plans for the subject area.

3. I do not expect any opposition to the presentation of this case by affidavit.

4. Chisholm seeks orders extending for an additional year the obligation to commence drilling under Division Orders R-21682 and R-21681 issued on May 17, 2021. These orders pooled all uncommitted interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying standard 320-acre horizontal spacing units in the W/2 of Section 34, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, and the W/2 of Section 3, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico as follows:

- Order R-21682 pooled the W/2 W/2 of Sections 34 and 3 and dedicated the 320-acre spacing unit to the proposed **Jade 34-3 Fed Com 2BS 5H** and the **Jade 34-3 Fed Com 1BS 9H** wells.
- Order No. R-21681 pooled the E/2 W/2 of Sections 34 and 3 and dedicated the 320-acre spacing unit c to the proposed **Jade 34-3 Fed Com 2BS 6H** and the **Jade 34-3 Fed Com 1BS 10H** wells.¹

Each order requires Applicant to commence drilling the wells “within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well.”

5. Chisholm intends to drill the initial wells for the spacing units approved by Division Orders R-21682 and R-21681 from two enlarged well pads in the N/2 NW/4 (Units C and D) of Section 34.

6. Chisholm encountered delays obtaining the necessary approvals from the Bureau of Land Management to enlarge the drilling pads for the proposed wells. Applicant has recently received the necessary approvals and anticipates being able to commence drilling within a year.

7. Applicant therefore requests that the Division amend the existing pooling orders to extend the time to commence drilling the initial wells to May 17, 2023.

8. I provided the law firm of Holland & Hart LLP a list of names and addresses of the working interest owners that remain subject to these pooling orders and instructed that they be notified of this hearing.

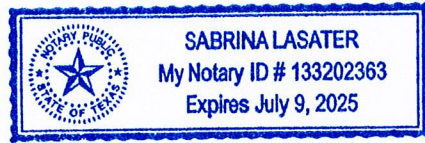

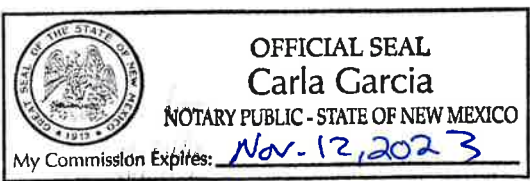
