The Unit will be dedicated to the **Sapphire Fed Com 501H Well** (API No. Pending), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot D) of Section 14, to a bottom hole location in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot M) of Section 23. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.

The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.


