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STATEMENT OF CASES

In Case No. 22332, Marathon seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2 of Sections 18 and 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the Colossus 18-19 WA Federal Com 1H well, to be horizontally drilled. The producing area for the well will be orthodox. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said well, the allocation of these

costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 13 miles Southwest of Jal, New Mexico.

In Case No. 22741, Marathon seeks an order from the Division approving a non-standard spacing unit and pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2 of Sections 18 and 19, Township 26 South, Range 35 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the Colossus 18-19 TB Federal Com 2H and the Colossus 18-19 TB Federal Com 3H wells, to be horizontally drilled. The wells will be drilled at orthodox locations. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing said wells, the allocation of these costs as well as the actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Marathon as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling said well. Said area is located approximately 13 miles Southwest of Jal, New Mexico.
