## **APPLICATION**

In accordance with NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, COG Operating LLC ("COG" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, files this application with the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 640-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Sections 9 and 16, Township 24 South, Range 32 East, Lea County, New Mexico ("Unit"). In support of this application, COG states the following.

- 1. Applicant (OGRID No. 229137) is a working interest owner in the Unit and has the right to drill thereon.
  - 2. Applicant seeks to dedicate the Unit to the following proposed wells:
    - a. The **Double ABJ 16 Federal Com 501H well**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 9; and
    - b. The **Double ABJ 16 Federal Com 502H well**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 16 to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 9.
  - 3. The completed intervals of the wells will be orthodox.
- 4. The completed interval of the Double ABJ 16 Federal Com 502H well will be located within 330'of the quarter-quarter section line separating the E/2 E/2 and W/2 E/2 of Sections 9 and 16 to allow for the creation of a 640-acre standard horizontal spacing unit.

- 5. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all of the interest owners in the Unit.
- 6. The pooling of uncommitted interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.
- 7. In order to permit Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all uncommitted interests in the Unit should be pooled and Applicant should be designated the operator of the proposed horizontal wells and the Unit.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on July 7, 2022, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the Unit;
- B. Approving the initial wells in the Unit;
- C. Designating Applicant as the operator of the Unit and the horizontal wells to be drilled thereon;
- D. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping, and completing the wells;
- E. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- F. Imposing a 200% charge for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the wells against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the wells.
