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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In **Case No. 22226**, Legacy applies for an order to create a standard spacing and proration unit and pool all uncommitted mineral interest owners within the Bone Spring Formation (GEM; BONE SPRING, EAST 27230) underlying a standard approximate 320-acre horizontal unit comprised of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 14 and the W $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico ("Unit"). The Unit will be dedicated to the **Sapphire Fed Com 501H Well** (API No. Pending), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot D) of Section 14, to a bottom hole location in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot M) of Section 23. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.

In **Case No. 22227**, Legacy applies for an order to create a standard spacing and proration unit and pool all uncommitted mineral interest owners within the Bone Spring Formation underlying a standard approximate 320-acre horizontal unit comprised of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 14 and the E $\frac{1}{2}$ W $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico ("Unit"). The Unit will be dedicated to the **Sapphire Fed Com 502H Well** (API No. Pending), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ (Lot D) of

Section 14, to a bottom hole location in the SE¹/₄SW¹/₄ (Lot N) of Section 23. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.

In **Case No. 22228**, Legacy applies for an order to create a standard spacing and proration unit and pool all uncommitted mineral interest owners within the Bone Spring Formation underlying a standard approximate 320-acre horizontal unit comprised of the W¹/₂E¹/₂ of Section 14 and the W¹/₂E¹/₂ of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico (“Unit”). The Unit will be dedicated to the **Sapphire Fed Com 503H Well** (API No. Pending), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW¹/₄NE¹/₄ (Lot B) of Section 14, to a bottom hole location in the SW¹/₄SE¹/₄ (Lot O) of Section 23. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.

In **Case No. 22229**, Legacy applies for an order to create a standard spacing and proration unit and pool all uncommitted mineral interest owners within the Bone Spring Formation underlying a standard approximate 320-acre horizontal unit comprised of the E¹/₂E¹/₂ of Section 14 and the E¹/₂E¹/₂ of Section 23, Township 19 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico (“Unit”). The Unit will be dedicated to the **Sapphire Fed Com 504H Well** (API No. Pending), to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW¹/₄NE¹/₄ (Lot B) of Section 14, to a bottom hole location in the SE¹/₄SW¹/₄ (Lot P) of Section 23. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.


