Case No. 22769: Matador Production Company seeks an order amending Order No. R-21784, issued on July 15, 2021, to extend the well commencement deadline one year, to July 16, 2023. Order No. R-21784 pooled mineral interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2W/2 of Section 3 and the E/2W/2 of Section 10, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, for purposes of drilling the Nina Cortell Fed. Com. Well Nos. 112H, 126H, and 132H. It requires the commencement of drilling within one year of the date of the order unless the operator obtains an extension by amendment of the order for good cause shown
