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**S SUPPLEMENTAL SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF MITCH ROBB**

Mitch Robb, being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and states:

1. I am a landman for Mewbourne Oil Company (“Mewbourne”), and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have been qualified by the Division as an expert petroleum landman.

2. The above cases, combined, seek to pool to pool the N/2 of Section 25 and the NE/4 of Section 26, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, NMPM, for purposes of drilling two Deep Ellum 25/26 Bone Spring wells.

3. At the hearing (by affidavit) in June 2022 the Examiners asked why the NW/4 of Section 26 was not included in the well units, and whether there would be stranded acreage as a result.

4. The NW/4 of Section 26 was not included in Mewbourne’s well units because it is within a Chevron-operated federal unit (BLM No. NM 070938A).

5. In addition, I have confirmed with Mewbourne’s geologist that there are no Bone Spring well units within two miles of the NW/4 of Section 26 except a well in the N/2N/2 of Section 2, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, NMPM. See Exhibits 3A and 3B, submitted at the hearing. Thus, Chevron can drill north, west, or south from the NW/4 of Section 26.

I understand that this Self-Affirmed Statement will be used as written testimony in this case. I affirm that my testimony in paragraphs 1 through 5 above is true and correct and is made under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico. My testimony is made as of the date written next to my signature below.
