WPX Energy Permian, LLC ("WPX" or "Applicant") (OGRID No. 246289), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation (Purple Sage; Wolfcamp (Gas) Pool [98220]), underlying a 431.99-acre, more or less, standard horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the W/2 of Section 26 and Lots 7-10 of irregular Section 35 (NW/4 equivalent), Township 26 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. In support of its application, WPX states:

- 1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant seeks to initially dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the proposed **Steel Guitar 35-26 Fed Com 451H well**, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 26 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 NW/4 (Lot 9) of Section 35.
 - 3. The S/2 NW/4 of irregular Section 35 borders the Texas state line.
- 4. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all interest owners in the subject spacing unit.

5. The pooling of interests will allow Applicant to obtain a just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on December 1, 2022, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the horizontal spacing unit;
- B. Designating Applicant operator of this spacing unit and the horizontal well to be drilled thereon;
- C. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, completing, and equipping the well;
- D. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- E. Imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.

Application of WPX Energy Permian, LLC for Compulsory Pooling, Eddy County, New Mexico. Applicant in the above-styled cause seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a 431.99-acre, more or less, standard horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the W/2 of Section 26 and Lots 7-10 of irregular Section 35 (NW/4 equivalent), Township 26 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said unit will be initially dedicated to the proposed Steel Guitar 35-26 Fed Com 451H well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 26 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 NW/4 (Lot 9) of Section 35. Also, to be considered will be the cost of drilling and completing the well and the allocation of the cost thereof, actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of Applicant as operator of the well, and a 200% charge for risk involved in drilling the well. Said area is located approximately 17 miles south of Malaga, New Mexico.
