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APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF CASE

In Case No. 23119, Devon seeks an order (1) establishing a standard 320-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Sections 22 and 27, Township 25 South, Range 32 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, and (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral

interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying said unit. Devon proposes and dedicates to the unit the **Haflinger 22-27 Fed Com No. 304H Well**, as an initial well. The proposed well will be orthodox in location.

Devon proposes the **Haflinger 22-27 Fed Com No. 304H Well,** an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 22 to a bottom hole location in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 27.
