**STATEMENT OF THE CASE**

**APPLICANT**

Mewbourne Oil Company seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 9 and the NE/4 of Section 8, Township 18 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to: (a) the Double Stamp 9/8 B2AB Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 9 and a last take point in the NW/4NE/4 of Section 8; and (b) the Double Stamp 9/8 B2HG Fed. Com. Well No. 1H, a horizontal well with a first take point in the SE/4NE/4 of Section 9 and a last take point in the SW/4NE/4 of Section 8. The producing interval of each well will be orthodox. Applicant requests that the wells be dedicated to a non-standard 480-acre spacing and proration unit in the Sand Tank Bone Spring (oil) Pool. Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating

costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, testing and equipping the wells.


