APPLICANT’S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In Case No. 23554, Devon seeks an order (1) establishing a standard 800-acre, more or less, spacing and proration unit comprised of the NE/4 of Section 27, and the N/2 of Sections 26 and 25, all in Township 20 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico, and (2)

pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying said unit.

Devon proposes the **Prairie Fire 27-25 Fed Com 331H Well**, an oil well, to be dedicated to the unit and horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 27 to a bottom hole location in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 25. The **331H Well** is a proximity well, positioned so the unit can include proximity tracts located within 330 feet of the well's completed interval, thereby incorporating the S/2 N/2 of Sections 25 and 26, and the S/2 NE/4 of Section 27, in order to establish the larger unit covering the N/2 of Sections 25 and 26, and the NE/4 of Section 27.

The proposed well is orthodox in its location, and its take points and completed interval comply with setback requirements under Statewide Rules.
