Case No. 23696: Texas Standard seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interest owners in the Upper Penn formation underlying a horizontal well unit comprised of the (ii) W/2SE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., and (ii) the W/2E/2 of Section 3 and the W/2NE/4 of Section 10, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the Bulldog State Well Nos. 1H and 2H.

Case No. 23697: Texas Standard seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interest owners in the Upper Penn formation underlying a horizontal well unit comprised of (i) the E/2SE/4 of Section 34, Township 16 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., and (ii) the E/2E/2 of Section 3 and the

E/2NE/4 of Section 10, Township 17 South, Range 36 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. The unit will be dedicated to the Bulldog State Well Nos. 3H and 4H.

Also to be considered will be the cost of drilling, completing, and equipping the wells and the allocation of the cost thereof, as well as actual operating costs and charges for supervision, designation of applicant as operator of the wells, and a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, and equipping the wells.
