Matador Production Company ("Matador" or "Applicant"), through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division to extend the drilling deadline under compulsory pooling Order No. R-22396. In support of its application, Matador states:

- 1. On November 22, 2022, the Division entered Order R-22396 in Case 22572 pooling the Bone Spring formation underlying a standard 320-acre horizontal well spacing unit comprised of the E2SE4 of Section 18, the E2E2 of Section 19, and the E2NE4 of Section 30, Township 24 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico (the "Pooling Order"). Matador is the designated operator under the Pooling Order and the pooled spacing unit is initially dedicated to the proposed **Huneke Fed Com 138H** well.
- 2. As of the filing of this application, the drilling permit on file with the Bureau of Land Management has not been approved.
- 3. Good cause exists to extend the deadline to commence drilling the initial well under the Pooling Order.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on November 2, 2023, and, after notice and hearing as

required by law, the Division enter an order extending until November 22, 2024, the deadline to commence drilling the initial well under the Pooling Order.
